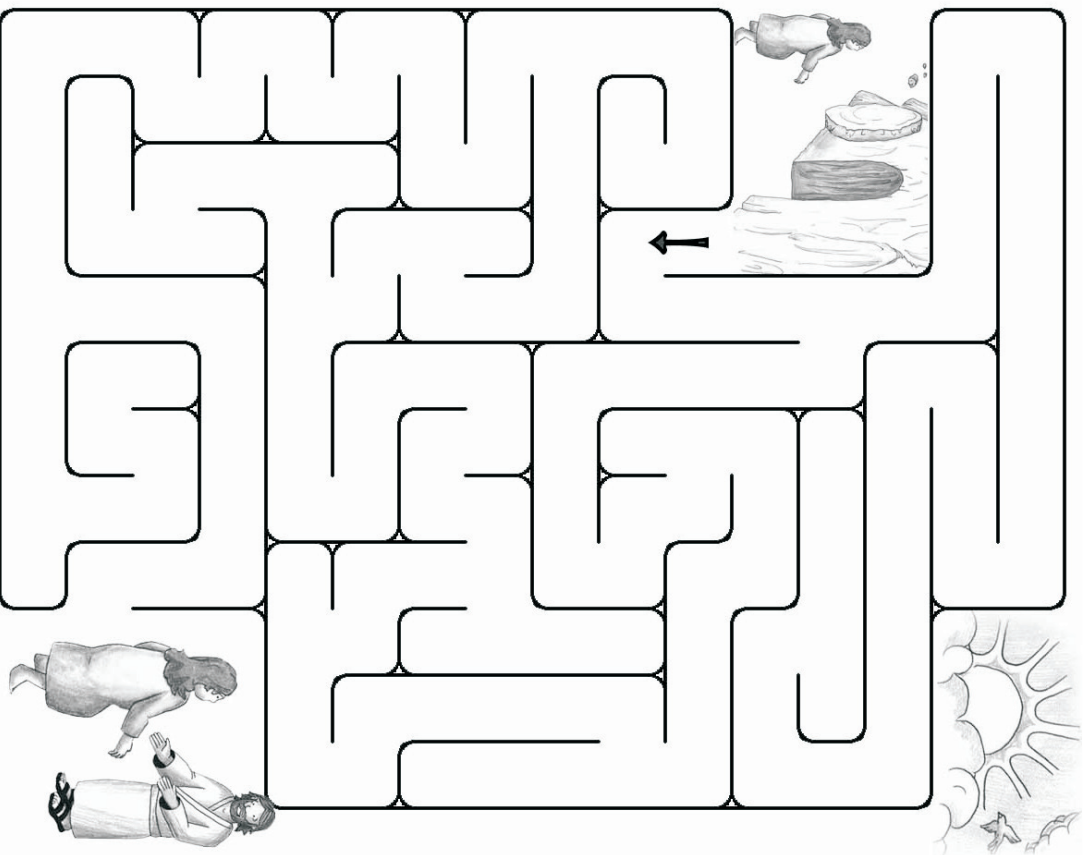


Mary told the disciples,
"I have seen the Lord!"



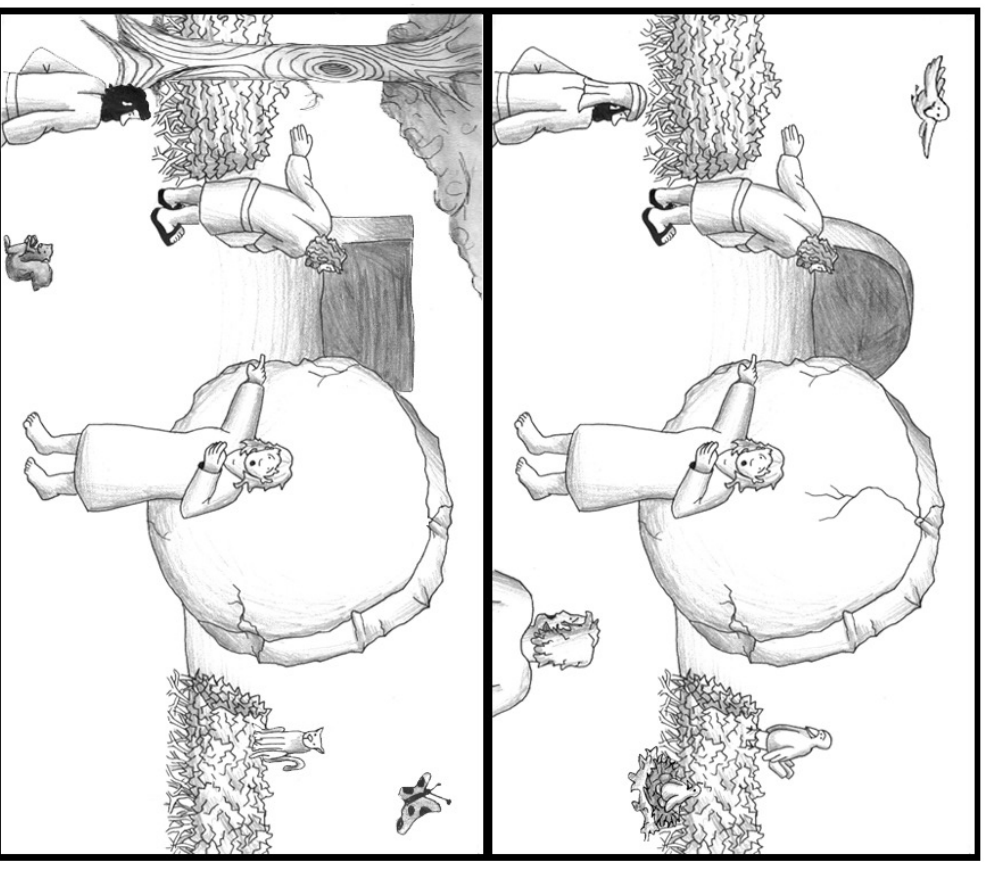
Help Mary through the maze to Jesus.

Jesus told her to go tell the disciples.

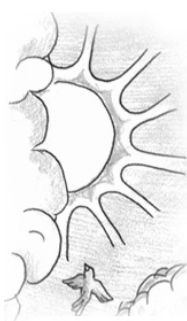

The disciples went back to their own home.

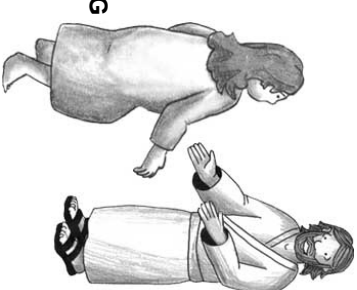
Early on the first day of the week, Mary Magdalen went to the tomb, and saw that the stone had been moved away. So she ran and told Peter and John.
